REQUEST FOR BIDS

BIGHORN SHEEP FENCE INSTALLATION PROJECT

1. What is the process for the Public Opening of Bids?

All bids received by 3 pm on Monday, January 13, 2020 will be opened at that time and the bid amounts will be announced publicly. All bids must be received by 3 pm to be considered. The bid opening will occur shortly after 3 pm.

2. Does the Coachella Valley Conservation Commission have a DIR#?

As described in the Request for Bids, all submittals must include a DIR# which has been assigned by the Department of Industrial Relations to you as a contractor. The Coachella Valley Conservation Commission (CVCC) is not required to have a DIR#. The CVCC will file a PWC-100 with the Department of Industrial Relations to register the project within 30 days from the date the contract is awarded.

3. On page 1 of the Notice Inviting Sealed Bids, it states that “All bidders shall possess a valid Class A (General) License and/or other specialty licenses applicable to this project at the time the bid is submitted.” Is a C-13 license acceptable?

A C-13 license is acceptable.

4. Do you have a detail for the Flapper gates? Or at least dimensions? Are there any specifications?

Dimensions and specifications for the Flapper gates were not included in the Request for Bids. An example of the likely design for the flapper gates is shown in the following photograph. We expect to work with the selected contractor and appropriate local agencies to determine the dimensions, design and number of flapper gates needed. The selected contractor will have input on this matter. As noted in the Request for Bids (see page 6, Gate Specifications), your sealed bid should clearly indicate the cost to install one flapper gate on Attachment 1 (page 12).
